



XBRL™ TRADEMARKS: GUIDELINES FOR USE and TRADEMARK LICENSE

Guidelines for Use

XBRL™ and XBRL EXTENSIBLE BUSINESS REPORTING LANGUAGE™ (the “Marks”) are trademarks and service marks of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (“AICPA”) that are solely licensed to XBRL International, Inc. (“XBRL International”) and sublicensed by XBRL International for use on software (see the Trademark License set forth below). You may use the Marks only to refer to the XBRL products and services licensed by AICPA or sublicensed by XBRL International, including the XBRL™ specifications, taxonomies, schema, samples and other documents (“Documents”) and related software (“Software”) available at <<http://www.xbrl.org>> (the “Web site”) and only provided that you adhere to the following guidelines:

1. The owner of the Marks must always be identified as AICPA. For example: “XBRL™ is a trademark of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (“AICPA”).”
2. Other than as provided in the Trademark License, you may not use the Marks: (i) on your products or as an indicator of source; or (ii) to suggest an affiliation with, or certification by, AICPA or XBRL International.
3. You must only use the XBRL Marks in a way that accurately reflects the status (the “Status”) associated with the XBRL™ Document. The Status of an XBRL™ Document describes the context in which the Document was developed, including the publication date, intellectual property disclosures (e.g., copyright or patent terms), location (URL), publication level (e.g., Note, Working Draft, Proposed Recommendation, Recommendation) and future expectations regarding the XBRL™ Document.
4. Other than as provided in the Trademark License, you may not use any logos of AICPA in connection with the Marks.

Trademark License

XBRL International, Inc. ("XBRL International") grants you a nonexclusive, royalty-free license to use XBRL™ and XBRL EXTENSIBLE BUSINESS REPORTING LANGUAGE & Logo™ (collectively, the "Licensed Marks") on software (the "Licensed Product"), subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. You acknowledge that AICPA is the owner and XBRL International the sole licensee of the Licensed Marks and that your rights are solely those of a sublicensee, and you agree that nothing herein shall be construed to establish or evidence your ownership of the Licensed Marks.
2. You shall clearly identify the owner of the Licensed Marks as AICPA on the Licensed Product and all promotional, advertising or other materials displaying or using the Licensed Marks. For example: "XBRL™ is a trademark of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("AICPA").
3. You recognize and acknowledge the importance of the exercise of control over the quality of your use of the Licensed Marks by AICPA and its sole licensee XBRL International (collectively "Licensor"). You shall comply with Licensor's quality control standards and shall, upon Licensor's request, submit for inspection samples of the Licensed Product and other materials, including advertising materials, using the Licensed Marks. IN NO EVENT SHALL LICENSOR OR ITS STEERING COMMITTEE, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES OR ATTORNEYS BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO USE OF LICENSED MARKS, INCLUDING ECONOMIC DAMAGES AND LOST PROFITS, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER LICENSOR SHALL BE ADVISED, SHALL HAVE OTHER REASON TO KNOW, OR IN FACT SHALL KNOW OF THE POSSIBILITY OF THE FOREGOING.
6. In the event you commit a material breach of this License, which remains uncured 30 days after Licensor provides you with written notice of such breach, Licensor may terminate the License. For purposes of this section, breach of the quality control provision in Section 3 shall be considered a material breach.

This License shall be deemed to have been made in the State of New York, and shall be construed and enforced in accordance with, and the validity and performance hereof shall be governed by, the laws of the United States of America and the State of New York, without reference to principles of conflicts of laws.

Licensor and you hereby irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state or federal court in the state and county of New York in any action or proceeding arising out of or relating to this License, and hereby waive any objection to the propriety or convenience of venue in such courts and irrevocably agree that all claims in respect of any such action or proceeding may be heard and determined in such courts.
